- After lunch head To Bhaktapur Durbar Square- A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Bhaktapur Durbar Square is a living museum of Nepalese art, culture, and architecture. The square is home to centuries-old temples, intricately carved wooden windows, stone sculptures, and the iconic 55-Window Palace. Walking through its brick-paved courtyards feels like stepping back in time, as the city still preserves its rich Newari traditions, crafts, and timeless charm.
